



English Requirements KG3 Going to Grade 1

Oral Language

Students will be able to:

- Express their needs and ideas in complete sentences and through direct requests.
- Use complete sentences that include subject, verb, and object.
- Identity beginning, middle, and ending sounds.

Reading

Students will be able to:

- Identify and name the uppercase and lowercase letters of the alphabets.
- Identity the vowel letters.
- Identify and read the high frequency words (I, see, we, he, she, me you, they, like, can, what, said, for, of, is, on, was, the, a, to, have, here, little, my, are, do, go, and, am, with, want, this, help, too, has, play, look).
- Identity and read short CVC words.
- Read High Frequency Stories and answer questions related to them.

Writing

Students will be able to:

- Print the uppercase and lowercase letters of the alphabet independently.
- Print his/her first and last name.
- Print the high frequency words mentioned above in addition to the short vowel sounds (CVC words).
- Identity sentence structure and write their own direct and indirect sentences using high frequency words and CVC words.
- Answer comprehension questions related to short stories.
